1. Discount disposal rates may be available upon approval of management.
2. All rates are subject to change without notice.
3. All incoming loads being dumped in the landfill will be billed with a 1-ton minimum charge.
4. All prices charged by the cubic yard will be based on the size of the truck as solely determined by Dominion Recycling Center.
5. Any contaminated material or special waste must be approved by management prior to acceptance.
6. All loads of asphalt shingles must contain a minimum of 90% asphalt shingles as solely determined by Dominion Recycling Center.
7. NO CONTAINERS WITH ANY WASTE MATERIAL SHALL BE STORED ONSITE. Any container being stored onsite that contains waste material will be charged a \$200 fee plus the cost to dispose of the load. Any container being stored onsite for longer than 7 calendar days that contains waste material will become the property of Dominion Recycling Center.
